Farm Loans Program To Be Restricted

Steps to be taken immediately in the farm housing loan program to curtail the use of building material for non-defense purpose and prevent Government loans from being used to pay inflated construction costs, were announced by Secretary of Agriculture Brannan today.

The action was requested by President Truman when he asked the Secretary to take comparable action to that being carried on by other Government agencies in the urban housing field.

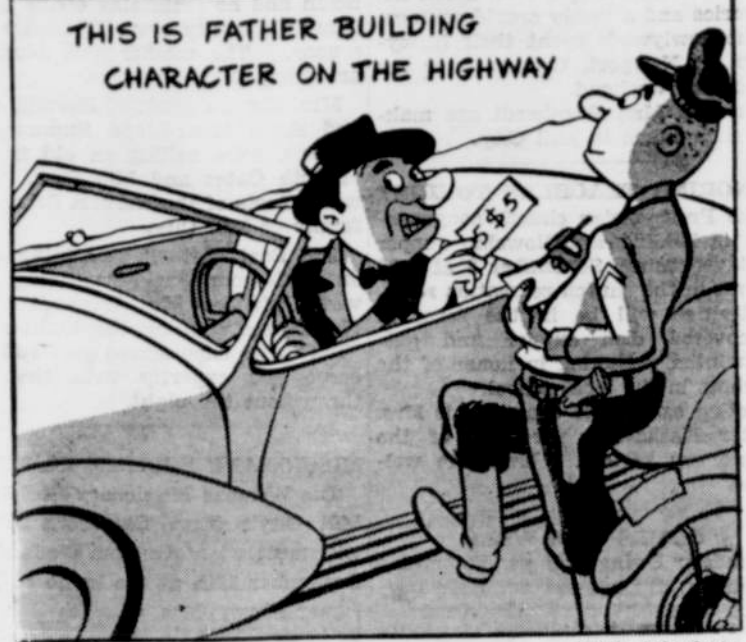
From now on a farm building loan will be approved only when the amount of the loan plus any other indebtedness on the farm does not create a total debt in excess of 95 percent of the appraised value of the farm. Previously a borrower's real estate debt could be as high as 100 percent of the value of the farm.

To prevent government loans from being used to pay inflated prices for labor or building materials, all loans in the future will be limited to 95 percent of the building costs estimated as of July 1, 1950. To meet higher costs the borrower must use personal funds or materials he already has on hand. This is the first time a restriction of this type has been used.

The farm housing loan program started last November under authorization of the Housing Act of 1949. As of June 30, about 4,000 loans totaling \$18,000,000.00 had been closed.

CORN BROOM GIRL



Fran Warren, Singing Star

Texas Guinan used to greet visitors to her famous night club by shouting "Hello Sucker" at them as they entered. The folks who wine and dined in her saloon—oops, salon—could afford to be suckers. Can you—when you go to market to buy a broom?

Above you see Fran Warren, beautiful star of radio and television, picking out a broom. She's being careful to get one with good stitching so that it will do the job well. What does Fran Warren know about brooms? Well, she's now being called "The Corn Broom Girl" since she made the popular RCA recording of the liting tune, "An Ordinary Broom Reminds Me Of You."

Now, she and the National Broom Manufacturers and Allied Industries Association offer you a few tips on how to buy a broom.

First, pull back the outer fibres of the broom and make sure the inside fibres are made of genuine broom corn, too. All strands should be of full length, to make the broom lively and resilient.

Be certain the broom's stitching is tight and even, and that there are an adequate number of rows of stitching. Loose sewing with the twine may cause the broom to fray out too soon. Finally, check the number of stitches to the row. The greater the number, the tighter and better and longer-lasting the broom.
