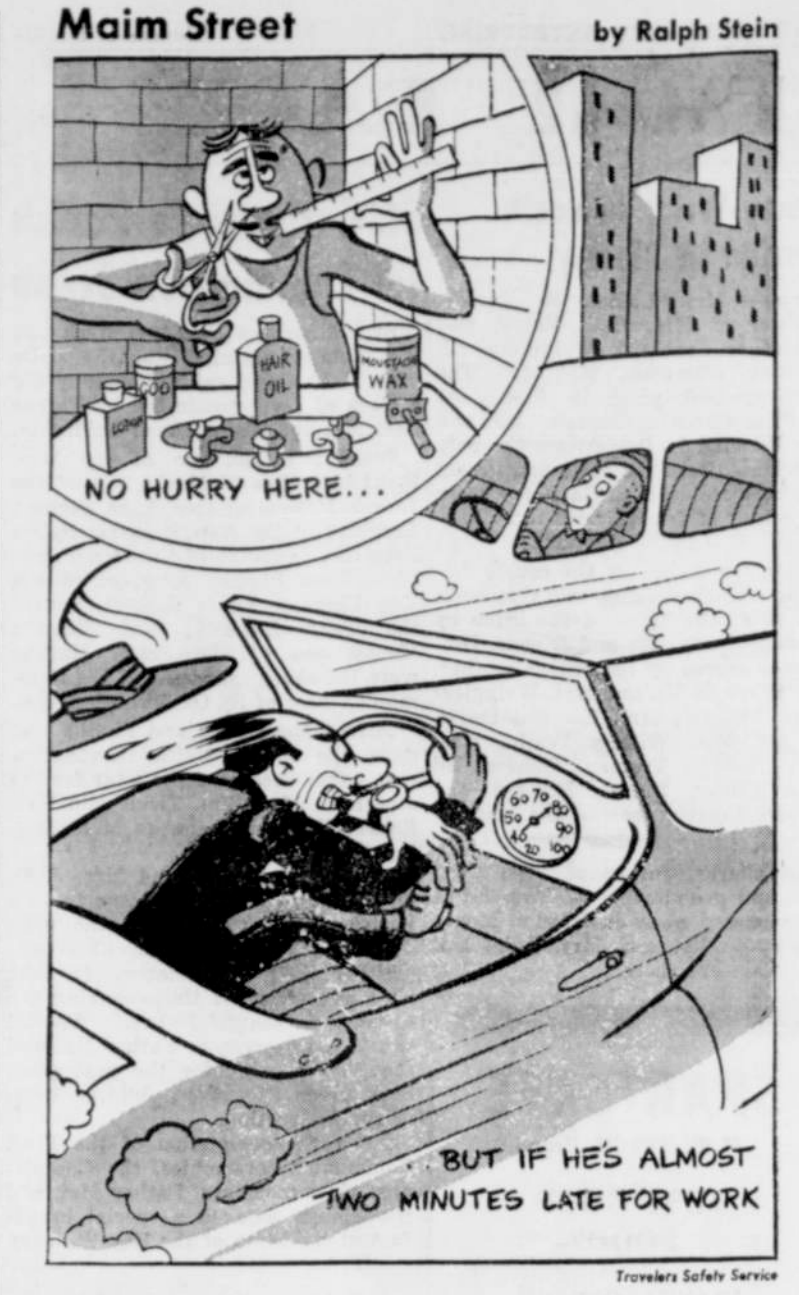
Mrs. Vern Nydigger has returned home from the Salem Memorial hospital after spending several days there for medical treatment.
