Your new cabinet sink should have a recessed front to provide knee room and a recessed toe space to make working at the unit easier on the legs and back. Deluxe models have other features, too, that take the drudgery from kitchen work—such as a handy soap-box rack on the undersink compartment door; compartmented drawers for cutlery, and a rinse spray.

Think of the cabinet sink as a labor saving device and insist that your new one be the kind that will lighten the kitchen load.


