This open letter is your personal invitation to participate in the 100% Marion County chest x-ray program to discover unknown cases of tuberculosis. lung cancer, and heart abnormalities.

Every adult resident of Marion County will be urged to have a chest x-ray between July 18th and August 11th. There will be no charge for these x-rays. Not only will you gain the assurance that you do not have a health condition that needs correction but your participation will insure the success of this program to protect you from future exposure to tuberculosis.

Such a 100% survey has been made possible through the availability of 18 mobile x-ray units on loan from the federal government for this single "all-out" effort. Successful surveys have been completed in Seattle, Spokane, and San Diego. This Willamette Valley survey in which Marion County has joined is approved and actively supported by our county medical profession and civic leaders.

This 100% survey is necessary because the limited number of mobile units available for past routine examinations has made it impossible to examine more than 10% of the people.

The equipment is on a matching basis. The government will furnish the units and technicians. We are responsible for the local costs, which will amount to approximately \$12,000 for Marion County. So far. \$4,000 has been raised. The balance must come from those who recognize the value of this program to the health of our community and who will underwrite this cost.

S. population has some form of allergy, which, if ignored, often develops into more serious conditions. This can be avoided, however, because new methods of treatment are dramatically effective in coping with these annoying allergies.

it, no more serious than the effects of a common cold. In another experimental study, this drug was given in doses of 500 milligrams a day to patients every day for six months. Drs. Judd and Henderson of the Pennsylvania State Department of Health, Hamburg, Pennsylvania, reported not a single untoward ef-fect in any of these patients.
