## Dedication Planned At Christian Church

Gates—The new Christian church which has been under construction for some time, is nearing completion and dedicatory services are planned for Easter Sunday. A pot-luck dinner will be featured at the noon hour on that day, and the afternoon will be given over to the dedication ceremony.

The church is located on a site facing the school grounds on the Linn county side of the river, donated for the purpose by Mr. and Mrs. Lang Stafford. Volunteer labor together with the fine co-operative spirit of those most closely interested, have contributed immeasurably to the success of the venture.

Gates has been without a church building since about 1925. According to Mrs. Ned Richards who was a little girl just past the pigtail age at that time, the old church was started in 1896 on a location a little to the south west of the center of Gates on the Marion county side of the river. She recalls the occasion of the men clearing the ground and of the women folk serving dinner to all hands.

No regular pastor was in charge, it seems. Sunday school classes were taught each Sunday, but preaching was divided with the Elkhorn community by a minister on alternate Sundays.

It was a pretty little church in a pretty setting of fir trees and it served its purpose well until the vicissitudes of fortune left Gates somewhat on the decline. Then it was, in about 1925 according to Mrs. Richards, that someone stole the heating stove, after which the pews were moved into the high school building where services were continued. Soon, the young Davids of the community for want of a Goliath to slay, began to blast the windows with slingshots and stones. The brick chimney went to complete some collector's set of bricks. The doors disappeared. The window casings and wainscoting in turn were diverted to more worldly purposes, until at last, but a mere shell of the former building remained.

As it ceased to function as a place of worship, the property on which it stood became a tax liability and in time went to the county for delinquent taxes. From there it was turned back to private ownership and what remained of any value has since been salvaged for private use.

Today, little remains to mark the hallowed spot, or to refresh the memories of those like Mrs. Richards whose lore reaches back to the nostalgic days of tin types, autograph albums and wax cylinder-type record phonographs. On windy days the young firs towering above the former site, moan and sigh in a humanly

plaintive note, reminiscent of the vanished voice of the old organ that also went the way of the heating stove, the brick chimney, the window casings and—the Indian.
