about the future of the canyon, they have continually expanded and re-invested here. The appliance store is still here—it has only moved in with the furniture store and nothing has left town. The boys who bought out Dave Epps are willing to invest in the future of the canyon. They have lived in Salem for several years and believe in the future of this location—the people of this canyon will not let them down!

As soon as the dam is completed so that the roads leading into timber behind the dam is accessible work will begin on the old mill property here in Mill City so that lumber can be processed here in the canyon.

Without doubt many have purchased lots in the new Detroit townsite—I would too if I had a little cash to spare. But that does not say that they intend to build on the lots, now or any other time in the future—it is just a good investment. I will venture to guess that building will not speed up if consolidation is voted down, while if the districts vote to consolidate building will show a real spurt, because then they will know that their property will not be overburdened by excessive school taxes. I am of the belief that our school taxes can never be too much, but many will not wish to assume taxes that are two or three times that of a neighboring district. We in America have never seen fit to spend on schools what we do for movies, tobacco, or our liquor, that is why I say we never can pay too much for our schools—we should to get the best there is available.

I think the only valid reason Mr. Schlador has given is when he objects to transporting children as far as 35 miles, so I say you must weigh the value of the education you want to give your children. Children used to walk two and three miles when I was a boy in Minnesota in all kinds of weather to get an education—today they can ride 35 miles in much less time and in comfort and safety to get the best available along a scenic highway that could be an inspiration for more and better study. What better example of the results of an education could any student get than passing the monumental work of man-made dams set in a surrounding of God's natural handiwork—truly inspiring.
