Ed Davis is convalescing at his home since the first of the week following a stay of several weeks in the Salem Memorial hospital prior to and following major surgery.

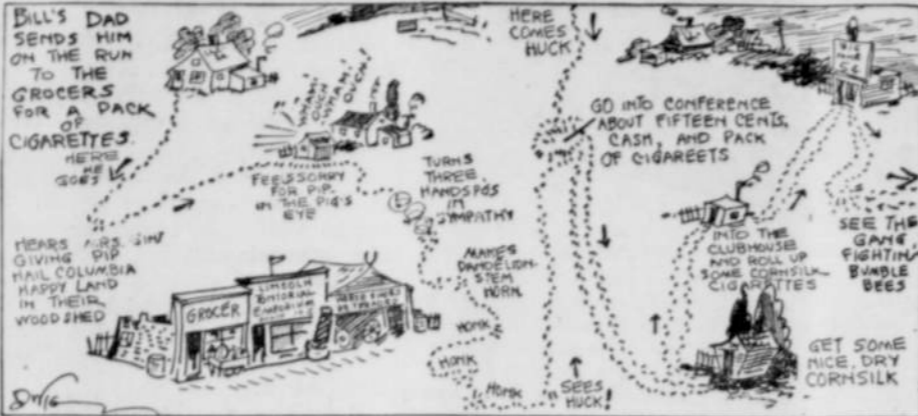
Mr. and Mrs. Burrel Cole and son, BM3 Thurlo Cole, spent several days fishing in Cutler City and Taft.

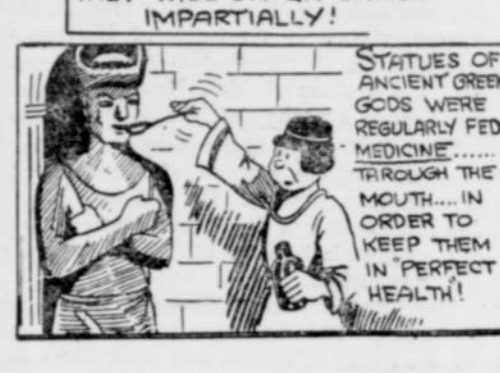

(1) Drew Middleton in his book, "The Defense of Western Europe," gives several reasons why he thinks the Western forces can halt a Soviet attack in Europe.
