When the regulatory bodies of state after state issue orders, to hand over on a silver platter the entire \$1,600,-000,000 of accelerated amortization benefits to the stockholders instead of to the rate-payers, then we can well conclude that state regulation is not merely a failure but a hopeless failure. As an associatoin it may not be improper for us to consider the adoption of a resolution urging the exemption of all private electric corporations from regulation by public utility commissions.
