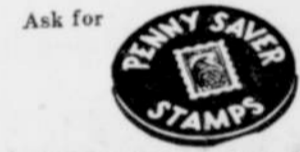

## Changes Made In 4-H State Fair Exhibits

Changes in the 1953 4-H state fair exhibits have been announced by Cal Monroe, state 4-H agent. They include beef, dairy, dairy goats, dairy herd record keeping, sheep, hogs, rabbits, poultry, horticulture and entomology.

Monroe says the changes will be included in the new state fair premium list to be published soon. They represent suggestions from many groups to provide better educational experience, larger participation and to eliminate unnecessary regulations.

A major change in the livestock rules provides that 4-H animals in the market classes be judged on a group basis. Market animals, which must grade "good" or better to be eligible for any award, will be placed in blue, red and white award groups.

Rabbit exhibitors must show their own rabbits which will be judged on a group basis with emphasis on conformation and production. Flower enthusiasts may show up to three exhibits of different flower varieties this year. Mixed bouquets will be replaced by single variety exhibits.

The state 4-H office also announced state fair judges for 4-H livestock exhibits. They are Joe Johnson, Oregon State College, beef; Walter Leth, Monmouth, and Joe Cox, Hillsboro, dairy; Ralph Bogart, OSC, dairy goats; Edward Gath, Turner, sheep; O. M. Mikesell, Albany, and Doug Chambers, Salem, hogs; and Dan Law, Portland, rabbits.

## SOAP IS PICNIC ACCESSORY
