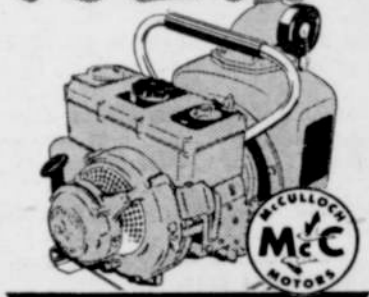

Frank Smith of Sheridan spent several hours in Mill City Sunday, making plans for a hunting trip next weekend.

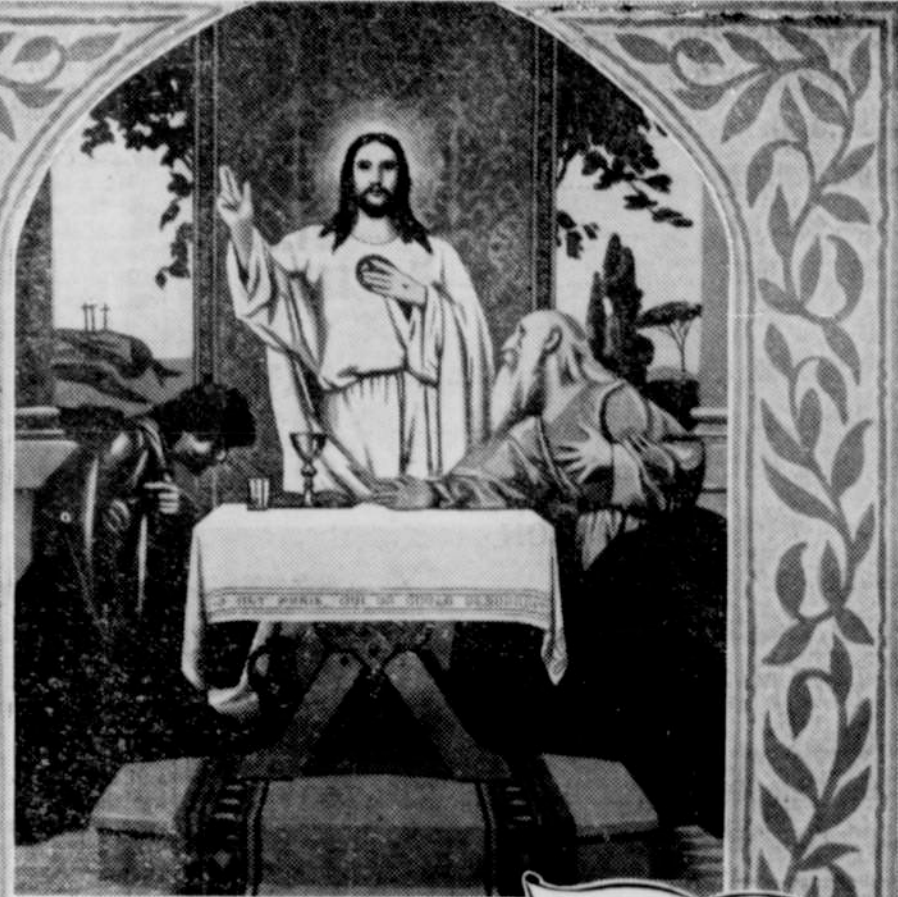

THE CHURCH FOR ALL... ALL FOR THE CHURCH

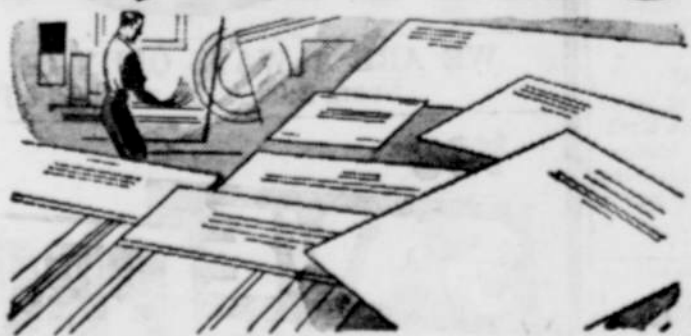
