### 286 People Killed Traffic Accidents

Oregon street and highway smash-ups during September gave that month the third worst traffic death rate so far this year, the state traffic safety division said Saturday.

The death rate, based on the number of persons killed as compared with miles traveled, hit 5.6 for September. This means, the division said, that for each 100 million vehicle miles traveled slightly more than six persons were killed in collisions.

September's traffic toll, 41, boosted Oregon's count so far this year to 286. While this is below that of the corresponding period last year, the safety office said that reports for October gave every indication that motor vehicle deaths are again climbing dangerously high.

Late fall and winter months produce dangerous driving conditions which the division says can be overcome only if the motorist adjusts his driving to road and weather conditions. Too much speed on slippery highways or in foggy weather are common driver mistakes which lead to accident involvement, the division concluded.

### Don't Use Park Lights In Foggy Weather

Oregon drivers were reminded Friday that use of parking lights for driving in "soupy" weather is a violation of law.

The state traffic safety division issued the reminder after observing numerous motorists using parking lights during early evening hours and when driving in fog.

These drivers, the division said, are inviting trouble because parking lights make it difficult for approaching drivers to see a car at a distance. In addition, motor vehicle laws clearly call for use of headlights "from a half hour after sunset until a half hour before sunrise," or at any time

when the driver's vision is limited to less than 500 feet. For driving in fog, the division recommended use of headlights on low beam since using high beam causes a reflection which partially blinds drivers.
