NOTICE IS GIVEN HEREBY that, at a special school district election hereby called, to be held at the schoolhouse in Mill City, in and for School District No. 129-J of Linn and Marion Counties, Oregon, on the 15th day of March, 1954, A. D., between the hours of 2:00 P. M. and 8:00 P. M., Pacific Standard Time, there will be submitted to the legal voters of said district the question of:

"Shall the sum of \$90,000.00 of the unexpended and unappropriated moneys on hand be appropriated as a special fund to acquire sites, build, improve, and equip buildings and grounds in said district?"

The vote on said question shall be by ballot, upon which shall be the words "Appropriation—Yes" and "Appropriation—No"; and the voter shall place a cross (X) between the word "Appropriation" and the word "Yes," or between the word "Appropriation" and the word "No," whichever indicates his choice.

The polls for the reception of the ballots cast for or against the appropriation of said moneys will, on said day and date, and at the place aforesaid, be opened at the hour of 2:00 P. M., Pacific Standard Time, and shall remain open until the hour of 8:00 P. M., Pacific Standard Time, of the same day at which hour the polls shall be closed.

Notice of this election shall be given by publication in The Mill City Enterprise, a newspaper published in Mill City in said district and of general circulation therein, for three (3) successive weeks, the date of the first publication shall be February 18, 1954, and the last March 11, 1954.
