STATE OF OREGON )

School District No. 129-J )

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a special school district election hereby is called to be held at the school house in and for said School District No. 129-J, Linn County, Oregon, on Monday, the 25th day of June, 1956, between the hours of 2 p.m. and 8 p.m. thereof. There will be submitted to the legal voters of said district the following questions:

1. Shall School District No. 129-J unite with School District No. 21-J, Linn County, Oregon, for the formation of a Union High School District for high school purposes only?

2. Shall the following described premises, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of said School District No. 129-J site; running north along said east boundary to the railroad right of way; thence Northwesterly along the railroad right of way to the western boundary of said school site; thence south along the western boundary of said site to the center of Evergreen Street; thence east along the center of Evergreen Street to the eastern boundary of the driveway to the grade school; thence South to the south line of said site; thence east to the place of beginning; containing approximately 11.498 acres, more or less; together with fixtures and equipment; reserving for School District No. 129-J, however, joint user in that portion of the site lying southerly of the south portion of the tract around the athletic field.

proposed as the site for said Union High School be transferred at a cost of One Dollar (\$1.00) as the site for the proposed Union High School.

That the vote upon said questions shall be by ballot upon which said ballot the following words shall appear: (1) Union High School—yes, Union High School—No; (2) For the transfer or property as a site—Yes, For the transfer of property as a site—No, and the voter shall place an "X" between the words "School" and the word "Yes", or between the words "School" and the word "No"; also, between the words "Site" and the word "Yes", or between the words, "Site" and the word "No", whichever indicates his choice of each of said propositions.

The polls for the reception of the ballots cast for or against the propositions will, on said day and date and at the place aforesaid, be opened

at the hour of 2 p.m. and will remain open until the hour of 8 p.m. of the same day, at which hour the polls shall be closed.
