

As I drove to the special service held at the Lyons Methodist church the reality of this sad day became even more apparent as I saw the flag at half-mast Wendell Weaver had been in front of the Mari-Linn Lyons I was surprised and shocked to se smoke billowing from the various mills on this saw shop at Gates from Max day of National mourning as proclaimed by President Johnson and Governor Hatfield.

Later as I sat at the organ and began the sad and majestic strains of Bach, the shrill sound of a mill whistle brought a terrible discord to the quietness of the music and the meditative thoughts of those present.
