PP&L Suggests Safety Guides For Irrigators

Agriculturalists who will soon begin operating sprinkler irrigation systems are reminded by Pacific Power & Light Company to exercise caution in handling metal pipes or other equipment in the vicinity of power lines.

"Carrying up-ended pipe or moving large mobile units beneath the electric wires have resulted in serious burns or worse almost every season despite continuous reminders of necessary safety precautions," explained PP&L's manager, Wayne Goin.

He urged irrigators to warn members of their family and new employees of potential hazards, and particularly any teenage youngsters who might be working on the ranch this summer for the first time.

The power company manager said all motors on pumps should be kept high and dry and clean, that switches should be tight and motors and switch boxes must be properly grounded.

"If a well casing is used for grounding, be certain that rubber gaskets or other insulating materials are bypassed by the ground wires," he added.
