This budget election to be held April 30, 1968 for the purpose of submitting to the voters of the city the question of whether or not a special tax in the amount of \$6,667.24 shall be levied to operate the City during the fiscal year 1968-1969. This tax, to require an additional levy estimated at \$1.31 per thousand dollars of true cash value of taxable property within the City, if approved will be in excess of the limitation on taxes imposed by Article XI, Section 11, of the Constitution of the State of Oregon, and ORS 478.410(1).
Due to new laws, the above wording is somewhat different than in the past years. However what it means is that the total tax inside and outside the 6% limitation for 1968-1969 will be \$16,186.00 compared to the total tax for 1967-68 year of \$19,171.00 or a reduction in taxes of \$2,985.00.
