NOTICE RE HIGHWAY DESIGN APPROVAL
In conformance with Policy and Procedure Memorandum 20-8, promulgated by the Federal Highway Administration, the Oregon State Highway Division has approved the highway design for right-of-way acquisition and construction on the Mehama Bridge Section of the Albany-Lyons Highway (ORE 226) in Mehama and Lyons in Marion and Linn Counties, Oregon.
The proposed location will basically follow new alignment westerly of the existing highway and will be a two-lane facility, consisting of two 12-foot travel lanes and 10-foot shoulders, and includes a new structure over the North Santiam River.
Maps and related data pertinent to the proposal are on file and available for review in the Highway Commission files, State Highway Building, Salem.
