MEASURE NO. 1
AN ACT to amend the City of Gates Charter of 1966, by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 40-A, providing for the enlargement, improvement, replacement, and repair of the city water system and the purchase thereof of pipes, hydrants, connections, mains, meters, valves, chlorinators, pumps, intake and pumping station equipment, structures, storage facilities, and property, and authorizing the

sale of not to exceed \$150,000 in general-obligation bonds to pay the cost thereof and the fixing of user charges and connection fees and the levying of property taxes, if necessary, to pay operation and maintenance costs of the system and the aforesaid bonds and the interest thereon and the pledging of the revenues of the system to pay the principal of and the interest on such bonds.

Complete copies of the foregoing proposed charter amendment are on file in the office of the City Recorder at the City Hall in Gates, Oregon, for public inspection.

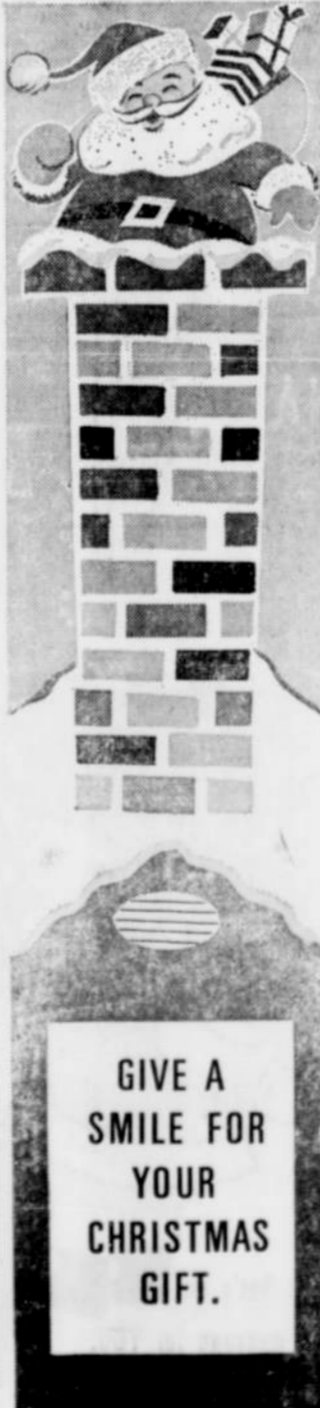
