Report to the People from Santiam Memorial Hospital

This week our topic is "who and What is a Hospital Administrator?"
Santiam Memorial Hospital is a community hospital. The board of directors hires the administrator, whose duty it is to administer the hospital to the desires of the board, as they are the representatives of the people. The Physicians are in private practice and upon

application, along with the proper credentials, are granted the privilege of being on the medical staff of the hospital.

The administrator of Santiam Memorial Hospital is Gale Christensen. He is the executive officer of the hospital and the representative of the governing body. The administrator is responsible for the proper management of the hospital as well as its relation to the patient, the public, the medical staff and the employees of the hospital.

It is his responsibility to manage the hospital in such a way as to gain the full confidence and active support of the community, so that the hospital will take its rightful place as the best among the health facilities of the community.

The administrator should maintain a good relationship with the medical staff. When problems arise, the administrator must remember that he is the representative of the governing body. He should ascertain that the appropriate policies which had been established for the welfare of the patient and the continued good reputation of the hospital are implemented. The administrator should hire only those people who have the talent and the know-how to do the job that they are hired to do. He at all times should be impartial, tolerant, fair, and should recognize the special interests of the various professional and technical groups employed within the hospital.

The administrator should endeavor to meet all legitimate requests of patients of comfort, general care, opportunity for observance of religious customs, and other comparable factors that will assist recovery. Relatives are to be treated with courtesy, and if firmness is required it should be exercised with judgment, tact and the minimum of embarrassment. The welfare of the patient is the primary concern of the hospital and thoughtful actions or requests of visitors must never be permitted to interfere with the patient's welfare.

It is the administrator's responsibility to keep in close touch with the community progress and particularly, community health needs. He assists the governing board in securing sufficient medical coverage for the community which the hospital serves.

It is the duty of the administrator to ensure compliance with all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations.

It is his duty to maintain accurate records of finances and activities, to enforce business-like control of expenditures, to safeguard, preserve, and replace the assets of the hospital.

The governing board charges the administrator with the proper management of the hospital. It is the administrator's duty to manage the hospital in the most efficient manner he knows, to purchase what is needed at the best possible price and quality, and give the patient the best care possible at the least possible cost.

The administrator determines the organizational lines of authority and fixes areas of responsibility. The administrator is responsible to the governing board.
