Year-End Review Shows Building Increase at Lyons

LYONS YEARLY REPORT
As 1972 comes creeping in and 1971 bids adieu, very cold weather was present causing a hardship on the loggers and mill workers, putting some of them out of work in early December. This little town of Lyons with a population now of 700 proves to be a busy place.

January—
Santiam mills from Lyons to Idanha were forced to close down due to the logs freezing. The large K-mart store in Salem had its roof cave in under the heavy snow. All officers of the Lyons-Mehama water board were retained for another term. Cal Culbertson, chairman; Dale Bilyeu, secretary and Chet Grimes treasurer. Mari-Linn school was closed for several days due to the deep snow. The March of Dimes Mothers march was held Tuesday evening, January 28.

February—
Alfred Bailey opened a saw shop in the former Ed Slayden shop east of town. National Assembly was observed at the Mari-Linn school. Lyons Dimes March brought in over \$150.00. Herman Free of Stayton, a former Lyons resident, passed away. Also, Esther Danielson of Lyons. A discussion was held on up-dating the street light at the council meeting and more landscaping was done at the City Library. Also, three more members passed on. Frank Durland, Lucille Lewis of Corvallis who was raised in Lyons, and Russell Thiel of North Bend, a long-time merchant here.

March—
Bids were to be opened March 25 by the State Highway Commission for a new bridge across the Santiam river. A five percent increase in customers and a 42 percent increase in one party lines were reported at the annual meeting of Peoples Telephone Company. Lyons was to enter the Beautification competition. Riverside Construction, Inc. submitted the low bid for a water system improvement project and water pipeline crossing at the new Lyons-Mehama bridge for \$40,458.

April—
A proposed \$22,500 city budget for 1971-72 was presented to the budget committee. It called for \$9,391 for general fund expenditures, \$2,071 less than the current year. The city levies no tax, obtaining its revenue from state cigarettes, liquor and gasoline tax allocations. Only one petition was filed for the May 3 Mari-Linn school election. Eldon Gilson filed for re-election. Twenty members from Santiam Valley Grange made their official visit to Lacomb Grange.

May—
Miss Beulah Lewis sold Lyons Variety store to Mr. and Mrs. Keith Phillips, after operating the store for 21 years. The annual Pet Parade from the Mari-Linn school was held. Postal rates were increased 6 cents to eight cents, and post-cards from five to six cents and airmail rates from 10 to 11 cents. Curtis Benefiel resigned as principal at Mari-Linn school and Clifford Babbitt offered contract. Eighth grade graduation at Mari-Linn school was held June 2.

June—
The City Council approved an annexation to the city of 24 acres east of the John Neal Park. They also approved annexation of property of George Nydegger, Bruce Sims and Thomas Hodges in April. Fire at the Cedar Lumber company did an estimated damage of \$25,000. The Lynn Scott Trailer was also destroyed by fire. Building permits were issued to A. L. Dawson to build three houses in the Wilson acres on 20th street.

July—
Lyons City Council established a Perpetual Cemetery trust fund. Bankmobile service was discussed and planned for the Lyons-Mehama area. Mr. and Mrs. Chester Riggs celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary. Temper-
