### Detroit Ambulance In Collision On Emergency Run

An ambulance on an emergency run from the Detroit area to Salem Hospital Emergency Center was involved in a collision late Friday at 25th and Mission Streets SE. Taken to the hospital by Willamette Ambulance was the driver of the Detroit ambulance Paul E. Van Fleet, 34, Detroit, the ambulance attendant, Harold C. Baker, 65, Id-

anha, and a patient in the ambulance, Darrell G. Snook, 17, 1245 Nebraska St. N. E.

Van Fleet was listed in serious condition Saturday night at Salem Hospital Memorial Unit with a concussion and bruises.

Baker was listed in fair condition with a possible fractured rib and internal injuries.

Snook was treated at the hospital and released. Salem police said Snook was being taken to the hospital for treatment of facial injuries suffered when he fell over a log near Detroit.

Police said the red light and warning siren of the ambulance were operating at the time of the collision although the ambulance crossed the intersection against a red light. No citations have been issued.

After several telephone calls to Portland Firms who rent ambulances, a contact was finally made late Saturday afternoon. Henry Hiebert of Idanha and Harold Champion, Detroit, drove to Portland to pickup the standby ambulance. No further word has been received about the District new ambulance which was earlier reported that it could be expected in July.

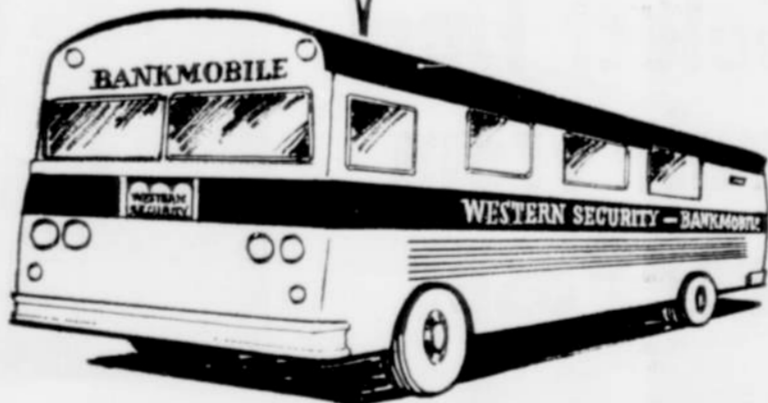
