Detroit Lake State Park Open Until November 30

DETROIT—Use of State Parks rose sharply during June, July and August this year, according to State Park Superintendent David Talbot.

Total attendance during the three-month period this year was 14,296,000, up 13.3 per cent during the same period in 1971. Overnight camp use rose 7.3 per cent, to 366,000 this year, according to the report.

Overnight camping at most parks will close October 31. An exception is Detroit Lake State Park which will remain open until November 30 for overnight camping.

Seven Parks stay open all year for overnight camping. They are: Fort Stevens, Cape Lookout, Beverly Beach, Honeyman, Bullards Beach and Harris Beach, all on the coast, and Valley of the Rogue near Grants Pass.

Juvenile Hunters Have Special Season

Although the season is already under way, juvenile hunters aged 14 through 17 have six more chances to hunt the E.E. Wilson Game Management Area located about 12 miles north of Corvallis without competition from adult shooters.

This is the 22nd consecutive year the Game Commission has sponsored the juvenile game bird season on this productive pheasant and waterfowl area to provide young hunters a quality learning experience in the art of wing shooting.

Shooting dates remaining this fall are October 7, 14, 21, 22, 28, and November 4. The first two dates are restricted to juvenile shooters only and the final four dates the juvenile as well as the accompanying adult may hunt.

Youngsters who wish to shoot on the game farm should contact the Game Commission Portland headquarters or the Corvallis regional office. A limit of 75 youngsters daily is permitted. Permits are issued free in the order that applications are received.

Applications must include the name, address, date of birth, hunter safety certificate number, the license number of the juvenile, and the address and hunting license number of the accompanying adult. The desired hunting date must be provided and an alternate choice in case the quota has already been filled.

A licensed adult must accompany not more than two juvenile hunters.

DETROIT—A drive to unite a Texas woman with her dying sister in Oregon failed. Mrs. Donna L. LaRiviere died October 7th of leukemia in a Portland Hospital before Salem's Capitol City Sertoma Club could raise \$250 needed to bring Mrs. LaRiviere's sister, Mrs. Jo Ellen Williams from El Paso to Portland.
