OREGON DEPARTMENT OF EMPLOYMENT NEWS
(This column is written weekly and published by this newspaper as a public and educational service. QUESTION:
How does seasonal farm employment stack up to averages of 10 years ago and why?

ANSWER:
According to the employment division's rural manpower service report for 1971, the average seasonal farm employment (May through October) the 1971 average was 26,934, of which 77.7 percent were local workers, 4.9 percent intrastate migratory workers and 17.4 percent interstate migratory workers. Comparable figures 10 years earlier (1961) showed an average of 34,160 farm workers, (May through October) with 71.6 percent local; 4.6 percent intrastate migratory and 23.6 percent interstate migratory.

Reasons given for the steady decline in farm employment in Oregon over the years are seasonal employment variations caused by weather conditions; the permanent effect of reduced acreages on harvest employment particularly in strawberries and pole beans; the relative stability of migratory employment in contrast to pronounced changes in total employment... and, of course, mechanization in most crops except pole beans and straw berries.
