Governmental Red Tape Prime Target of Solons
Government red tape has existed since man first recognized the need for central authority to maintain an orderly society.
The term as we know it today however, stems from the 'ape once used to bind official British documents. And, dictionaries describe it variously as an impedimental process and necessary official delay.
Red tape in this country has grown to such proportions that almost any politician finds it a solid plank during election campaigns. Once in office, lawmakers in particular spend countless hours mulling propositions that usually increase impediments in the official process.
Oregon lawmakers meeting in Salem may be an exception. This week marks the real beginning of a determined effort to slash red tape that has been accused of stifling an already staggering economy.
Specifically, legislators will be addressing the multiplicity

One witness guessed there was easily \$1 billion worth of construction projects helplessly snarled in bureaucratic red tape at a time the economy desperately needed all the employment it could get.
Edward J. Whelan, director of the state's department of economic development, quickly produced a list of seven such projects, each ensnarled one way or another in a tangle of red tape. Added together, their cost totals \$1 billion and represents an estimated 20,000 jobs or more in temporary and permanent employment.
A joint legislative interim committee on land use introduced the first bill designed to solve such problems this session and it has been joined by four more dealing with the subject. Each seeks a shortcut in its own particular way and designates some central authority to lead developers through the present bureaucratic maze.
Joint trade and economic development will conduct the first of what may be a series of public hearings on the package the morning of Thursday, April 3. Co-chairmen Sen. Victor Atiyeh (R-Beaverton) and Rep. Ed Lindquist (D-Milwaukie) have declared a solution this session is one of three priority goals for their committee.
They also have indicated the "working bill" the panel will

deal with most extensively is SB 903, introduced at the request of Gov. Bob Straub and Senate President Jason Boe (D-Reedsport).
That proposal already has been dubbed a one-stop shopping center for permits, to which developers can apply once and be assured all governmental agencies involved will receive notice of their intention and speedily respond with necessary permits or denials of permission. Particularly attractive to supporters is the fact the measure calls for action on permits within a specified time period in hopes of avoiding escalating construction costs.
The need for such a plan appears obvious in light of the fact a modest addition to a Salem hospital required approval by some 36 different agencies. Delays in obtaining approval from all three dozen bodies boosted construction costs an even \$1 million.
Central authority for permit coordination would be vested in the executive department, according to SB 903, and one public hearing would be substituted for the many that now plague some projects. All interested parties would be invited to participate in that

single hearing and subsequent intervention could be undertaken only by those participating in the original hearing.
One important provision in the Straub-Boe measure makes the shopping center approach optional. Persons dealing with relatively small numbers of agencies or those whose expertise enables them to thread through the process without assistance would not be required to participate.
Other important provisions likely will be amended into the bill, several of which are included in the package. One involves a study of all regulatory agencies to determine whether overlapping and duplicate jurisdictions can be reduced. Another would publish a catalog of agencies and make it available to the public. Others would provide for such assistance as a toll-free information telephone service and encourage federal agencies to join in the process with state and local governments.
It appears likely this legislature will provide a solution. But, lawmaking has red tape all its own and a struggling economy waits impatiently lest its rescuers fall victim to a common foe.
