A great deal has been said lately regarding a miner's inch and what constitutes a miner's inch of water. It may be of interest to some of our reader: who have read the controversy. In measuring a miner's inch of water, the surface of the water is to be exactly six inches above the center of the discharge. If the aperture be two inches in height, each square inch of the opening in the plank ( $11 / 4$ inches thick) will discharge a miner's inch - equal to .02499 cubic feet per second, 1.4994 cubic feet per minute, 89.964 cubic feet per hour, 2159.146 cubic feet per day of twenty-four hours.
