COUNTY COURT.

Adjourned Meeting. Continued from last week. LAKEVIEW, Oregon, May 20, 1901. In the County Court of the State of Oregon, for Lake county: In the matter of the return of delinquent taxes for 1900 by H. R. Dunlap, Sheriff.

This matter coming on to be heard upon the court's own motion to rectify and revoke the order heretofore made at the present term of this court, to wit: On May 4, 1901, and entered at page 421 of volume 4, Commissioners' Record of Lake County, Oregon, and appearing to the court that the return to this court of said sheriff heretofore made and filed on said 4th day of May, 1901, was and is irregular, and not in conformity to, or in accordance with, the requirements of the statutes of this State, and is therefore of no force or effect.

It is therefore ordered that said order heretofore made on May 4, 1901, and entered at page 421, volume 4, of Commissioners' Record aforesaid be, and the same is, hereby rescinded, revoked, set aside, and held for naught.

Done in open court this 20th day of May, 1901, at the regular May term. The court having fully considered and investigated the tax roll for the year 1900, for the purpose of ascertaining and determining all the taxes on said roll, which remain unpaid, and having taken and considered the evidence touching upon said matter, the court finds from such testimony that there remains unpaid taxes on said roll which fully appear in a list on file in this court marked "Exhibit H," Unpaid Tax List No. 8, which said list is annexed to the tax roll of said year showing the name of the person against whom the tax is levied, and giving the page and line of the tax roll for the year 1900 upon which the same appears in said roll.

Now, therefore, by virtue of the power vested in this court it is ordered and hereby directed that a warrant be issued for the collection of said unpaid taxes in the manner provided by law.

Ordered by the Court that H. R. Dunlap, Sheriff, be given credit for the unpaid taxes as returned on the tax roll for the year 1900; also for double assessments and taxes marked "void" by the Court.

Ordered by the Court that the Sheriff be credited with the following wrongful assessments:

- F. W. Pratt, \$408.60, roll 1900. A. Bieber, 5.46, roll 1900. Walter Faxton, 33.64, roll 1900. Ordered by the Court that warrants be drawn upon the Treasurer in payment of the following allowed claims, to-wit: Lake County Examiner, publishing, \$27.25. Glass & Prudhomme, office supplies, 53.33. H. S. Crocker Co., office supplies, 10.65. Jack Borie, labor, 4.00. J. M. Martin, commissioner's salary, 4.00. S. J. Prose, commissioner's salary and mileage, 9.60.

Court adjourned until Wednesday, May 22, 1901, at 10 o'clock a. m.

LAKEVIEW, Oregon, May 22, 1901. Court convened pursuant to adjournment May 20th, at which were present J. M. Martin and S. J. Prose, Commissioners, H. R. Dunlap, Sheriff, and Wm. Gunthier, Clerk, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

It appearing that A. J. Neilson has appropriated the funds collected by him as Tax Collector of the sum of \$9,381.93, it is hereby ordered by the Court that the County Clerk demand of said A. J. Neilson that he at once pay said sum to the Treasurer of the County.

And it appearing that of said sum J. Frank, George Jannerthal, A. McCullen and J. E. Bernard, as the bondsmen for said A. J. Neilson, are liable for the sum of \$4,229.49, it is therefore ordered that said bondsmen be likewise demanded to pay said sum of \$4,229.49 at once to the County Treasurer of this County.

In the matter of rebate on taxes: It appearing to the court from the affidavit of Thos. Ferris now on file in this court that said Thos. Ferris has paid to the Sheriff of Lake County, Oregon, \$23.21 taxes which were wrongfully levied, assessed and collected; it is therefore ordered that a warrant be drawn upon the Treasurer for said sum \$23.21, as follows:

Thos. Ferris, rebate on taxes, \$23.21. Court adjourned until May 23, 1901, at 10 a. m.
