

RAILROAD MOVEMENT.

President Lytle, C. S., Visits Eastern Ore.

The Oregonian tells of a trip made to Eastern Oregon by President E. E. Lytle of the Columbia Southern, accompanied by W. H. Moore and C. E. Lytle. The object of the visit was to view the country between Condon and Fossil, in Gilliam and Wheeler counties to determine upon the suggestion of building a branch road from the Columbia Southern, to leave the main line at Guthrie station, 15 miles north of Shaniko, and pass in a southeasterly direction down to the John Day river. The country through which the proposed line will run is an agricultural section. It is thought that if the road is built it will induce a big settlement. A preliminary survey of the proposed branch was made some months ago. Since then a careful examination of the country to be served has been made, and it is found capable of yielding a large volume of traffic when developed, and its development is expected to be rapid under proper encouragement.

President Lytle admits that the matter is receiving some attention. He is the gentleman who was recently interviewed by a representative of The Lake County Examiner two months ago, and who stated at that time that he would positively visit Lake county and Lakeview within sixty days. President Lytle also gave assurances that his road would build to Lakeview in the near future.

Without doubt, should the Columbia Southern start extension work toward Lakeview, the N-C-O management would get a two-minute gain on it and come on rapidly to meet the "Joe from the north."

Why Stockmen Are Growing Rich.

Those who say that the present high price of beef is a boom proposition may read the following from the Beeders' Gazette: Why is beef at its present high price? Who do men bid freely for high types of improved animals of the beef breeds? Why are the dairy breeds feeling the awakening? In 1900 we had in this country 10,000,000 less cattle than in 1892. In that time the population increased over 10,000,000. In 1892 we had 826 head of cattle for every 1,000 of population. In 1900 this ratio had fallen to 585 cattle for every 1000 people. During the eight years intervening between the years named we lost on an average over 1,000,000 of cattle per year. To maintain even our present ratio of cattle to population we must show an increase of about 1,000,000 cattle annually, and when these figures are added together some understanding of the present situation should be easy of grasp by the most misinformed mind.

The demand has not been so much for some special buyers as it has been general. The market for territory wools has shown a good demand. Fine medium and fine scoured staple is quoted at 43 and 44 while the strictly staple ranges up to 46@47. Fleece wools are quiet, with prices on many grades nominal.

ASHLAND vs. THE SALOONS

Judge Hanna Decides Against Defendant.

The Ashland Tidings says that in the matter of the petition for a writ of review of the case of the City of Ashland vs. Honck & Dame, for a violation of the liquor ordinances of the city in which Honck & Dame were fined \$100 for violating the ordinance in selling liquor by Recorder Milton Berry, Judge H. K. Hanna of the Circuit Court of the First Judicial District handed down his decision at 3 o'clock this afternoon. In the circuit court Honck & Dame appeared as plaintiffs and the City of Ashland as defendant.

This is a test case for all others under the same ordinance. It is reported that the case will be carried to the Supreme Court of the State of Oregon.

The opinion of Judge Hanna is as follows:

Now, on this 15th day of July, 1901, after careful consideration of said cause the Court finds that there was no error of law in the trial of said cause in said Recorder's Court, in said City of Ashland; and in the rendition of the decision therein. It is therefore ordered that the petition of plaintiffs, be denied and that the Recorder's Court of the City of Ashland be and it is hereby directed to proceed in the matter reviewed in accordance with its decision.

It is further ordered that the defendant have judgement for costs and that the clerk of this court spread on its records the proceedings herein as proceedings had in vacation.

China Loot Destroyed.

The Ashland Record describes the collision at Black Butte, Siskiyou county, referring to the soldiers' special which ran into the regular California Express as follows:

"The soldier special contained the famous Fifth Battery, U. S. A., en route from China to Fort Walla Walla, Wash., and was in command of Captain Ridgeway. This was the battery that did such fine work in scaling the walls of the Imperial City, the first volley of the Chinese Army killing the gallant Captain Riley and three others.

"Among the property destroyed by the collision was a large amount of loot the Fifth Battery stole from the Chinese in the taking of Pekin, being in the shape of vases, furs, rare coins, stamps, jewelry, and everything of conceivable interest to the human heart and eye. These goods were in the box car which was knocked into smithereens. The soldiers estimated the value of the destroyed goods at \$50,000.

"This battery was with the allied army that went out to the Dowager Empress' summer palace to bring her in. But she and the court had made their escape. They describe the palace as exceedingly swell and robbed it of everything. They gave the trainmen, passengers and neighbors all kinds of souvenirs from the wreck."

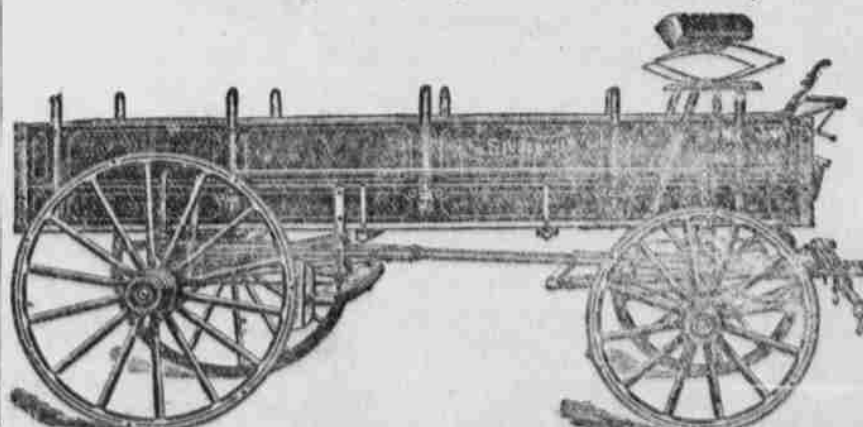
