

# SUEING OFFICIALS

**Pennoyer, McBride and Metschan, Ex-State Officials Made Defendants in the Davis Defalcation.**

The state of Oregon has brought suit against Sylvester Pennoyer, Geo. W. McBride and Phil Metschan, as governor, secretary of state and treasurer, respectively, during the period between September 1890, and January 1895, to recover the entire amount of the defalcation of Geo. W. Davis, clerk of the school land board appointed by them. Davis was appointed clerk of this board on July 14, 1901, giving bonds in the sum of five thousand dollars. Attorney General D. K. N. Blackburn and District Attorney J. N. Hart are attorneys for the state.

The total collections made by Davis during his term aggregated \$414,398.99, and the total amount paid to the state treasurer was \$383,566.91, leaving a balance of \$30,832.08.

The plaintiff alleges that the board was negligent and did not perform their legal duties, thus enabling Davis to appropriate to his own use the money not paid over to the treasurer.

A decree is asked by the plaintiff in the sums of \$14,419.49 and \$16,512.69, with interest at the rate of 8 per cent per annum from Jan. 1, 1892 until paid; for an accounting of the money not delivered to the treasurer, and for the costs and disbursements of the suit.

This is virtually a test case to establish whether or not the claim of the state is outlawed through the statute of limitations. It will probably go to the Supreme Court, and opens the road for endless litigation and the employment of legal talent by both sides.

Mr. Metschan went from Portland to Salem and the papers were served upon him. The six years from the date of Davis' retirement from office expired Aug. 1, 1901.

### Strike Averted.

It is said that a big strike was averted recently on the ranch of the Chewaucan Land & Cattle Company near Paisley, by the prompt action of Superintendent Wallace Taylor. The Post says a consultation was held among the men, and it was decided that as hands were scarce they could compel their employer to give them a raise in wages, but as the wages were fairly good and the men were well treated and had no just grounds for grievance, the proposed strike was not very popular among the more reasonable class of workmen. When several of the men lagged, refusing to go to work at the regular time, Superintendent Taylor immediately sent for his book-keeper to come on the ground prepared to make out the time of every man not in active service upon his arrival, and kindly told the men that all who wished to quit might do so. The result was that most of the crew went to work at once, though a few got their time made out and a check for same.

## THE JESSE CARR STOCK COMPANY.

**Commissioner Hermann Says Carr's Land Should be Restored to Public.**

The Jesse Carr Stock Co. has been exerting strong influence on the government at Washington, during the past week, says the Ashland Tidings, to maintain the fences it has on some 70,000 acres of the public domain. Indications are that in accordance with the decision of Judge C. B. Bellinger they will have to come down. Hon. Binger Hermann, Commissioner of the General Land Office, is thoroughly in favor of restoring the land to the public and doing away with Carr's illegal monopoly. He has reported to the Interior Department that the law specifically provides that no fence shall be erected on the public domain, and holds that Carr has directly violated the law. Mr. Hermann further contends that the public range should be open to all, and will make a strong recommendation to Secretary of the Interior Hitchcock that the U. S. Marshal be authorized at once to remove the fence.

Secretary Hitchcock in past cases of a similar nature has been very lenient with stockowners and given them years in which to remove a fence. In the absence of the secretary it is not known what recommendation his assistant will make. The Carr Company has induced Senator Perkins, of California, to plead for it with the departments; but it is not thought that he will be able to protect the illegal monopoly of the Carr Co. so thoroughly has public opinion been aroused over the matter. As the case stands it will cost the government about \$10,000 to remove the fences that the land-grabbing Carr Stock Company has erected.
