HOMESTEAD RESIDENCE

Visiting Your Homestead Only Occasionly Won't Go According to Spokane Decision.

The Spokane, Washington, land of fice has handed down a decision, which will probably be sustained by the highest authority if carried up. In brief, it is a question as to whether a person must reside apon this hard in order to hold a homestead. If the holder be single person the homestead must be his or her home. If the holder be a married pers n, it must be the home of his or her family, while the head of the family has to go elsewhere to earn money for improvements. This is the kernel of the decision. The contestee in this case was employed in the hardware business at Scott Station, Wash. and made his entry March 28, 1900, and soon thereafter he built a small house upon the land and plowed ten acres of When the house was finished the entrymen stayed one night and day upon the land, and since that time he made it a practice to spend a night at his cabin once in every six months. It has been repeatedly held by the land department that mere visits to the fand does not constitute a compliance with the law as to residence. In this case, it was held that the fact that the entryman was a single man did not excuse him from residing on his homestead, and that he had not established a residence upon the land by merely making a nightly visit every six months. His entry was therefore rancelled and the contestant was allowed preference of right of entry. Contestee was allowed 30 days inswhich to appeal.
