A CRITICISM FROM YANKEELAND.

It is easy to write a "comical" book—an imaginary tour of Uncle Bill or Uncle Joe to some city scene, such as has been done repeatedly; but to write a really humorous book of imaginary travels of a Yankee is quite another matter. The test of a true humorist is easily made, and Thomas Fleming, who wrote "Around the Pan With Uncle Hank," meets the demand made in such a case. Into the mouth of Uncle Hank the author has put a wealth of historical matter as well as a reservoir of humorous speech from which the reader gathers a great deal of information as well as a great deal of fun. We of New England know our own, and Uncle Hank is easily identified as "one of us." The large amount of reading matter is accompanied with scores of illustrations, large and small, many of them amusing in the last degree, and in the front appears a very fine medallion portrait of President McKinley, drawn with a single line. The book, of necessity, has its sober side, for the assassination of the President enters into it. Mr. Fleming illustrates his text. Experimenting on Dry Lands.

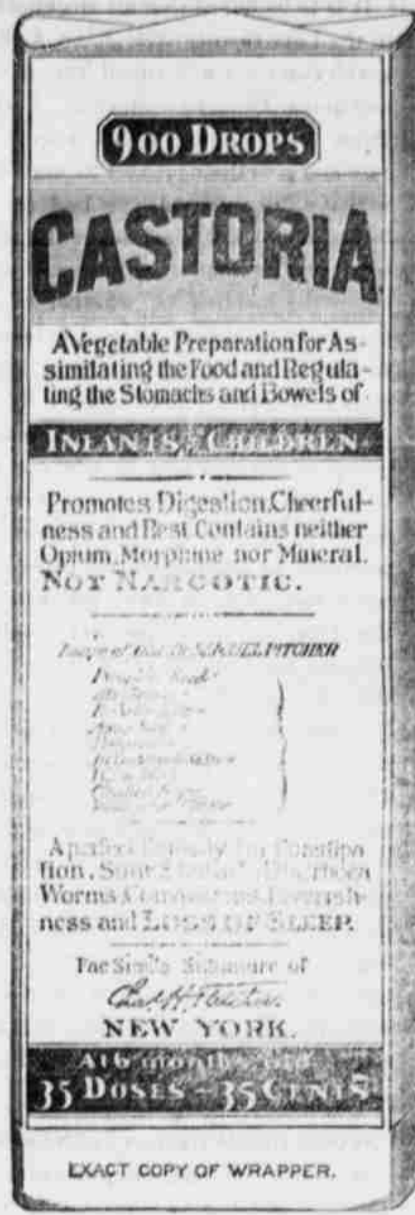
Ralph Foster came down from Summer Lake last Thursday. He has been on his desert ranch north of Silver Lake all winter preparing to raise a lot of dry-land hay this year. He will try alfalfa, rye, Bromus and several other kinds of dry-land grasses as an experiment, says the Paisley Post. The ground is warm and damp there and Ralph says that seeds planted will sprout and shoot out in six days. There is no doubt that experiments in dry-land grasses on the desert, properly conducted, will result in successfully adapting the semi-arid lands of Lake county to some specie of fodder that will revolutionize the greater portion of this county now lying idle for the want of a profitable method of utilizing the great waste desert. There are four or five ranches near that of Mr. Foster's all of recent acquisition, the owners of which are unionized in an effort to make a thorough test of the productiveness of the soil. The result of their experiments should be closely watched.
