It is ordered by the Court that the resignation of F. H. Snyder, road supervisor of district No. 12, Lake county, Oregon, be and the same is hereby accepted. And it is further ordered that A. N. Stanley be and he is hereby appointed to fill such vacancy.

It is ordered by the Court that the resignation of W. R. Heryford, County Road Master of Lake county, Oregon, be and the same is hereby accepted. It is further ordered that F. H. Snyder be, and he is hereby appointed to fill such vacancy and the undertaking of F. H. Snyder being deemed sufficient, the same was approved.

In the matter of the petition of H. A. Brattain and 39 others for the establishment of a County road.

Comes now H. A. Brattain one of the petitioners for the above named proposed county road, and presents to the Court the Petition of himself and others, praying for the location and establishment of a County road described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a point on the the west side of the Main street at the intersection of Mill street in the town of Paisley, Oregon, thirty feet southerly from the original town corner of said town of Paisley; thence westerly with the course of said Mill street 14 chains; thence southwesterly to intersection of subdivision line between the southwest quarter of southwest quarter, and northwest quarter of southwest quarter of section 24; thence westerly along said line to east boundary of section 23; thence continuing in the same direction in said section 23 to northwest corner of southeast quarter of southwest quarter of section 23, all in township 33, south range 18 east; thence by the best and most practicable route to the west boundary line of Lake county, terminating at the quarter section corner, being the southeast corner of the northeast quarter of section 24, township 34 south range 15 east, and is in duty bound your petitions will ever pray.

And it appearing to the Court that said petition is signed by more than twelve householders of this County residing in the vicinity of said proposed road, and that said petition properly specifies the place of beginning, intermediate points and place of termination of said road, and it satisfactorily appearing to the Court that notice has been given by advertisement posted at the place of holding County Court, to wit: at Lakeview, County of Lake, State of Oregon, and also in three public places in the vicinity of said proposed road, to wit:

One on the outer wall of the Withers Bros. store, near the southeast corner thereof, at Paisley, Oregon; one on the Cottonwood tree near the southeast corner of the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section 24, township 33, range 18 east; one on a cottonwood tree near the subdivision line between the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter and southeast quarter of southeast quarter of section 23, township 33, south range 18 east, for more than thirty days immediately prior to the presentation of said petition to the Court, notifying all persons concerned that application would be made to this court at the present session of this Court; and that the notices so posted were in due form and duly signed by the petitioners, and that a bond for the cost of this proceeding has been duly given.

It is therefore ordered that G. H. Aldridge, J. N. Watson and H. E. Reed be appointed viewers of said road, and that P. M. Curry, County Surveyor, survey said road, and that they meet at Paisley, Oregon, on the 9th day of June, 1902, at the hour of 9 o'clock a. m., and after qualifying, to view, survey and lay out said road according to law.
