State Superintendent's Report.

State Superintendent J. H. Ackerman has compiled the school statisties of the state from the reports received from the several county superintendents. The statement to be used in the bi-ennial report, shows that the total school population of the state is E38,466, according to the latest school census, of which numher 100,756 were on the school regis-

ters during the last school year. The school libraries of the state show a healthy growth, the number of books purchased during the year being 15,821, and the total number now in the libraries is 56,598. The total amount of money available for school purposes was \$2,383,074.93, and the amount expended, \$1,999,809. 43, leaving a balance of \$283,265.50.


