Another swarm of timber land locators have arrived in Ashland. bound for the Sprague River Valley, for which place they will leave by private conveyance, to-morrow, says the Ashland Tidings, Oct. 14.

They are mostly from the state of Iowa. Twenty-five of them arrived yesterday and fifty more-imong whom are ten women-joined them this morning, having come from Muscatine in a special car. The livery establishments of this section are now taxed to their utmost to accommodate those who are crossing the divide to Klamath in search of timber land. 
