Appraisers of Klamath Lands.

A dispatch from Washington, D. C., under date of Oct. 17, says that the Secretary of the Interior, on recommendation of Commissioner Herrmann, has appointed R. A. Emmett, of Keno, Nathaniel Lang Jr., of Medford, and Elmer L. Applegate of Klamath Falls, to appraise certain lands, formerly a part of old Fort Klamath military reservation. The lands are to be sold at public auction at not less than their appraised value.

The net receipts from the disposal of public lands in Oregon in the last fiscal year were \$546,025, against \$364,988 for the preceding fiscal year. These combined amounts go to the credit of the state and will eventually be utilized in constructing irrigation works within its boundaries under the new law. The gross receipts of the United States from public lands last year were \$6,261,427.

AN ALL ABIDING FAITH.

The Illinois Central Railroad Company has an all abiding faith in the future of the town Northwest. A short time ago, this was manifested by an establishment in Seattle of an agency to take care of their interests. This is the latest effort to maintain a substantial equipment in train service between St. Paul and Chicago. The road, it is said, will be running Sunday Nov. 11th. They will use their own road between Chicago and Albert Lea, Minn., and then Minnesota & St. Louis Ry. track from Albert Lea to Minneapolis and St. Paul, running outside Union Depot at St. Paul which is the same that is used by all lines of traffic.

The tracks to be known as the Chicago & St. Louis Minnesota & St. Paul "and will consist of double track, half liberty line and resounding intercoursing through Wisconsin along the St. Paul and Chicago line and St. Paul-Duluth line with the St. Paul, running over the same line of Chicago & Milwaukee into Chicago. That will leave St. Paul at 7:30 a.m. and arrive in Chicago at 9:30 a.m. The fare will be \$10.00 up and across \$8.00. \$10.00 a.m. making about \$8.00 p.m. St. Paul with an extra train. This can be purchased via this line, for connection with all western lines of traffic.
