LAW POINTS.

Previous notice is held in Bagley versus Reno Oil company (Pa.), 50 L. R. A. 184, to be indispensable to render valid a change at a regular annual corporate meeting in the bylaws of the corporation increasing the number of directors.

A tenant for life in possession of real estate is held in Hanna versus Palmer (Ill.), 50 L. R. A. 183, not to be able to obtain an absolute title to the property, either directly or indirectly, by suffering it to be sold for taxes and then acquiring a tax title.

A prosecution, maliciously and with out probable cause, of a civil action in which there has been no restraint of the person or seizure of property is held in McCormick Harvesting Machine company versus Wilian (Neb.), 50 L. R. A. 328, to entitle the defendant therein to damages.
