The St. Louis World's Fair will be approximately twice as big as any former international exposition.

The Centennial Exposition at Philadelphia covered 236 acres, the Paris Exposition of 1898-1900, 336 acres, the Columbian Exposition at Chicago 633 acres, the Pan-American at Buffalo 250 acres

The St. Louis World's Fair will cover 1200 acres.

The construction cost of the Paris Exposition was \$9,000,000, that of the Columbian Exposition \$18,322,000 and the total cost of the Pan-American Exposition was \$10,000,000.

The estimated cost of the St. Louis World's Fair will be \$30,000,000. This will mean \$40,000,000 by the time the work is completed.

Before the Exposition gates are open, the city of St. Louis will haveexpended the enormous sum of \$20,000,-000. Of this amount \$5,000,000 was appropriated for the Fair though the Municipal Assembly, her citizens raised \$5,000,000 additional by private subscription, and by popular vote at a special election the Charter Amendments were carried, will enable the city to expend \$10,000,000 for street paving and other public Improvements.
