
$\mathbf{A}^{\text {itesian Well Bill }}$ Of Great Benefit. A bill for an Act entitled an Act to wells in Eastern Oregou. Be it enacted by the Legislative Aseembly of the People of the State of Oregon: section 1. The county Judges the several Eastern Oregon counthe Morrow, Ghilman, Baker, Umatilla, ney, Malheur, Lake, Klamath, Union Wallowa, and Wheeler, are hereby constituted a commission with full powers to carry into e
Section 2. Each county named bove shall pay to the commission aforesaid, upon demand, out of the general fund of the county, an amount urer shall likewise pay a like amount: Provided, however, that payment proot that an equal amount ha already been pald into the artesian well fund by the counties.
Section 3. It shall be the duty of
the commission to cause to be drilled one well in each of the aforesaid counties.
Section 4 . The county court of the respective counties shall welect the location of the proposed well: Pro vided. however, that sald location
shall be made in the voting precinct that contributes the largest amount of money to the sinking of the well
so located: And, provided further that the minimum amount of such coutribution be $\$ 1,000$.

## Section 5. After expending all the

 money as provided for in sections and 4 in sinking any given well, thecommission may, if they think it advisable, continue sinking the well Provided, additional men
meribed for that purpose.
 whall be let in one contruct to such person or persons as shall submit however, that no bidnhall be accept rd without the filling of a gool and sufficient bond.
sonly applicable to the payment contract well drilling by the foot upon the completion of any given well, except that $\$ \mathbf{5 0 0}$, or so much thereof as may be necessary, may be used in way of advertising for bids
and to cover expenses of the commis. don; such expense to be charged pro rata against the several wells.
Sections. Inasmach us it is desirable to have the well test made un effect and be in force from and after ts approval by the Governor.
