TWO TAX PAYMENTS.

Change in the Law Makes it Necessary for Two Collections of Taxes in the Year 1904.

"Will property-owners in Oregon have to pay double the usual amount of taxes in the Fall of 1904?" is a question that is discussed at some length by Linn County citizens nowadays, says'an Albany correspondent of the Oregonian. Not that there is room for a great deal of arguement concerning the letter of the law passed by the recent session of the Oregon Legislature, but the inevitable effects of the law furnishing the question for discussion.

It will be recalled that at the last session of the Legislature House bill No. 107, entitled "An act to provide more efficient method for the assesswas passed, and later received the post mark will not be accepted. overnor's signature, thus becoming a law. This new law provides that, Beginning with January I, 1904, the taxes for each shall become due and be collected at least in part before the end of that year. That is, that the taxes for 1904 shall become due and paid in 1904, instead of in the following year, as has been the practice in the past in Oregon. The specific provisions of the law are that the taxes for each year may be paid by the 1st day of December of that year; but if they are not paid before the 1st day of February of the following year they shall become delinquent on that date provided, that if one-half of the taxes are paid before the first day of December, the remaining one-half may go over until the first day of the following April, becoming delinquent on the 1st of May. This law to take effect the 1st of January, 1904.

Now, then, the contention is that in the Fall of the year 1904, when the new system of collecting taxes is installed, taxpayers will be burdened with a double payment of taxes. Under the old law the taxes for 1903 will be collected in 1904. One-half of these may be paid in the Spring of the year 1904, and the other half in the Fall. As the 1904 taxes must be paid at least in part before the 1st day of December, 1904, would seem that in the Fall of that year onehalf of the 1903 taxes and one-half of the 1904 taxes or the taxes of a full year must be paid. This position is maintained by some of the leading ability of Albany.

It is generally agreed that the new method, when once established, will be much more satisfactory than the old. But it is also agreed that the doubling-up year will be a hard one for taxpayers.

It is argued that this new law has not been widely enough advertised. The general public does not seem to be apprised of the conditions which it will have to face next year. The law should be given greater publicity and the people warned that they should arrange to settle their 1903 taxes as early as possible after the assessment rolls are made up. In this way taxpayers will be prepared to meet the 1904 taxes, which come, In effect as an extra assessment in that year. But, fortunately, the jump is made during an era of generaly prosperity in the state.
