

## NEW LAW IN FORCE.

Requires Recording of Births and Deaths--Must Report to Co. Board of Health at Once.

One of the most important laws passed by the last legislature was that establishing the Oregon State Board of Health, which is clothed not only with drastic power for the regulation and control of contagious and infectious diseases, but it is made the duty of the board to see that provisions of the law for the keeping of vital statistics is enforced.

It is necessary now to make official record of every birth and every death. A new law that is already in effect, requires every physician, midwife or head of the family to give notice by the end of the month to the county health officer of any birth that occurs under his or her charge. Every physician, midwife or head of a family must give notice to such health officer within 48 hours of every death. No burial can take place until a proper burial certificate has been made out and transmitted to the county health officer.

All these requirements are the result of the act creating the state board of health, which passed the last legislature. It contained an emergency clause, and took effect on its approval by the governor, February 18. It creates a county, as well as a state health board. The county board is the county judge and county physician. If there is no county physician, then the county judge is the county board of health as well as the county health officer.

To this officer must be reported all infectious diseases, deaths, causes thereof, places of burial of every person that dies in said county, and in the case of birth of any child give name of parents, their residence and their occupation.

Power is given the county board of health to quarantine against infectious diseases in other county or counties of the state, to quarantine any case or cases of infectious diseases within said county, and to call upon all police officers, sheriffs and constables to enforce such quarantine. All cases of birth, death, burial and infectious diseases are reported by the county health officer to the secretary of the state board of health where a complete record is kept.

The new law will add materially to the duties of the county judge, all physicians and others. The penalty for violation of the law is a fine of not less than \$10 or more than \$100.

## REAMES HAS HARD RACE.

He Must Overcome Plurality of 1134 Made by Furnish—Hermann Best Vote Getter.

If Democrats are going to elect Reames to Congress their candidate must get more votes in the first District than did Chamberlain in the race for Governor last June, says the Oregonian. Furnish carried the district against Chamberlain by a plurality of 1134 votes. The pluralities of the two candidates in the several counties were as follows:

Hermann is regarded by Republicans as a much better vote-getter than Furnish. Many Democrats who see that Hermann will carry Marion and Douglas, two counties which lined up for Chamberlain, believe that their party is confronted by a Republican plurality which cannot be beaten, if Republicans will turn out and vote.

United States Senator Fulton was in Portland yesterday, and estimated that Hermann would carry the district by a plurality between 4000 and 5000.

"Hermann should get 2000 or 3000 more votes in the district than did Furnish," said Senator Fulton.

### Fish Almost Extinct.

The fishing season is now near at hand and the usual kick about the destruction of fish may be expected to come up at any time, says the Post. The Chewaucan river a few years ago was the best trout stream in Southeastern Oregon, the past two years have seen thousands of fish sluiced out on high lands through irrigation ditches and left high and dry to perish in the sun, till now the river is almost destitute of the finny beauties. No consideration has been given the fish and they have been let run out in canals and ditches, and when the owners of these ditches see fit to turn the water fish can be found thousands in a pile dead. It is only a matter of one or two summers when there will not be a fish in the river. There is a law to protect fish, but those who are responsible for the wholesale destruction of fish wield such power that lovers of trout have been unable to cause the law to be enforced for the protection of the fish. The destruction of fish is more from the lack of interest in the propagation of trout than from any motive to destroy.
