

**A Spicy Case.**

Last week T. W. Roberts, the Los Angeles horse buyer, swore to a warrant charging Jennie Mulloy and "Red" Forquer with stealing a team of horses. Mr. Roberts claims that he purchased the team of Mrs. Mulloy in Lakeview for \$130, and that she afterward took the team from the pasture and made away with them, says the Alturas New Era.

They were brought before Justice Henderson for examination last Saturday. The examination lasted all Saturday and was not finished until Monday noon.

Judge Henderson took the case under advisement until 10 o'clock Tuesday, at which time the defendant Mulloy was discharged from custody.

Defendant Forquer asked for a continuance of his examination and was given five days.


