OLD SOLDIERS IN CONGRESS.

Although the Civil War has been over thirty-eight years, there will be seventy-seven men in the Fifty-eighth Congress who fought in it, says the Washington Dispatch. Forty-seven fought on the Union side and thirty cast their lot with the Confederacy. In the Senate there are thirteen Union soldiers and thirteen Confederates. In the House there are thirty-four who fought for the North and seventeen who fought for the South. In the Senate there are three men who were Brigadier-Generals in the Confederate army and two who were Union Brigadiers. In the House there are three Federal Brigadiers, while the highest rank held by the ex-Confederates is that of Colonel.

Pennsylvania leads, having six veterans in Congress. New York has five, all in the House. On the Confederate side Alabama heads the list with five.

There are fourteen ex-Governors in the Senate.
