ty or parties who killed said sheep are non-residents of Lake County, Oregon,

Now, therefore, in conformity with law and to the end that justice may be done, it is hereby ordered that the County Court of Lake County, Oregon, while sitting for the transaction of county business do offer and promise to pay the sum of one thousand (\$1000.00) dollars for the arrest and conviction of the said party or parties who have wantonly and unlawfully killed said sheep.

Court met pursuant to adjournment all officers present, W. A. Currier, Commissioner, absent, when the following business was transacted to-wit:

WHEREAS at an election held on the 6th day of June, 1904, F. O. Ahlstrom was duly elected County Treasurer for the County of Lake, State of Oregon, and whereas the said F. O. Ahlstrom has filed his certificate of election and oath of office with the County Clerk of said County;

It is hereby ordered that the official undertaking of said F. O. Ahlstrom as such Treasurer be and the same is hereby fixed in the sum of Fifteen thousand (\$15,000.00) Dollars. The said undertaking to be duly executed in the form and manner as required by law and submitted to this Court for examination and approval.

In order that the official work of the county officers of Lake county, Oregon and the examination of the books of said officers hereto made by the County Court be checked up and thoroughly scrutinized before a final settlement be made with said officers for the two years ending on July 5th 1904.

It is hereby ordered that J. Frankl, an expert accountant be and he is hereby employed to assist said County Court in making a thorough examination of the official acts and bi-annual reports of said officers before delivering said books to the County Officers elect.
