

Russian War Ship in San Francisco.

The armored cruiser *Lena*, a Russian war vessel, sailed into San Francisco bay last Sunday, and gave a surprise to three nations. The Washington authorities were at once notified, also Russia and Japan were cabled of the arrival of the *Lena* in neutral waters an incident giving rise to much excitement, especially just at this time when it was supposed that the U. S. war vessels of that port were on a cruise down the coast, but which trip had been delayed, and were to have started the following day—however the U. S. war vessels, New York, Boston, Marblehead, Paul Jones and Burlington remained in the harbor awaiting developments. Also several cargoes of freight were ready for transportation, and it was thought by some that the *Lena* was here to look for contraband of war. Her boilers were said to be leaking, and she sailed here for repairs, otherwise she could not remain in port more than 24 hours unless she dismantled and hung up till after the war in the Far East.
