

### Nativity of the Voters.

O. P. Hoff, Oregon State Labor Commissioner, has compiled from the last registration lists of the state, statistics of the nativity of the voters of the several counties of Oregon. Of the nearly 4000 voters who registered in Jackson county previous to the last June election less than 400 are shown to be foreign born. The nativity of the voters of this county as well as those of Klamath and Lake counties are found to be divided as follows:

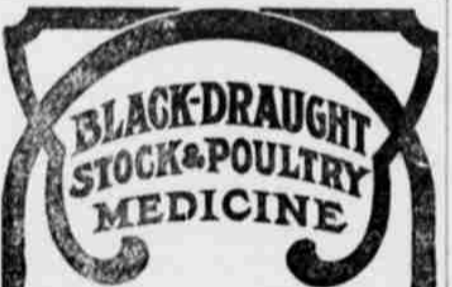
