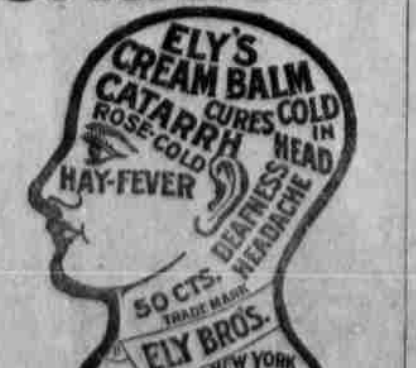

The official count of the votes in Modoc gives the Republican electors 559, Democratic electors 449, Socialists 18, Prohibitionists 16, making a total of 1,032 votes cast in the county and going Republican a majority of 94. As a matter of fact a large number of voters failed to register or vote in the county. In this precinct alone about 45 Democrats and 20 Republican failed to register or vote. Two years hence a full vote will be polled.—(Cedarville Record).

Arrangements have already been made to have President Roosevelt touch a button that will set in motion the machinery for the Western World's Fair, and it is thought there will be no difficulty in arranging for the additional feature of the chimes.
