

Japanese and Korean Showmen Exhibit Great Skill in Educating Birds and Beasts.

Japanese and Korean showmen, in addition to their skill as jugglers and acrobats, display a truit marvelous skill in teaching and mals tricks. They not only exhibit educated bears, spaniels, monkeys and goats, but also trained birds, and, what is most astonishing of all, trick fish.
