Heavy Rains Everywhere.

The most violent rain storms that have been experienced for years have prevailed in Southern California recently. Telegraph and telephone communication was cut off and many trains were tied up for several days. All over Oregon there has been an unprecedented down pour of rain. For Lake county, and similar localities these rains are a Godsend, coming as they have, just after crops are all in the ground.
