A fire started in the great Sutro tunnel, on the Comstock lode, Nevada, recently at a point 5000 feet from the Virginia City end, and for a time endangered the lives of hundreds of miners in the tunnel and in the Virginia City mines, as their air supply might have been cut off.

Valuable treasure has been discovered near Eakus, 40 miles southwest of Port Sula. It includes a gold diadem and a complete ureus crown, over a hundred gold coins and numerous bracelets. This is expected to prove one of the most interesting of Egyptian discoveries, owing to the unusual nature of the articles brought to light. The mention of a ureus, or snake crown, suggests to archeologists that the treasure is of Ptolemaic rather than Roman origin. The asp was the symbol of Kneph, or the good genius, and was used as an emblem of royalty.

Another valuable addition to Italy's treasures in medieval works of art has just been brought to light. In the old church of Cregglo, near Orvigno, some internal repairs and structural cleaning are being carried out. Among the rest, a thick coating of whitewash has been removed. Fortunately, with a view to possible discoveries underneath, this was done with care, with the result that there have been found six different frescoes of the best period of Italian art. They are all by the eminent painter, Grandenzio Ferrari. The color is said to be splendid.—London Globe.
