Reclamation Law a Detriment.
The Burns Times-Herald says, in commenting upon the action of the government Reclamation Service in abandoning the Malheur irrigation scheme in Malheur county and the Silvias project in Harney county, that so far, instead of being a benefit to these two counties, the Reclamation law has been a detriment. These two projects have been favorably recommended to the service all along, by every engineer that has visited them and after nearly two years of suspense the hopes of the people of these two counties are shattered. It is hinted that the organization of the Christian Federation, and its known desire to acquire some valuable tracts of land in Eastern Oregon, has been instrumental in causing the abandonment of these two projects. The Federationists recently took an option on the French-Glenn property in Harney county, for which they were to pay \$1,800,000, the first payment of \$50,000 to be made the first of September. It is now believed by some that the deal will not be made, and the Federationists will undertake to buy the land embraced in the two irrigation projects, a large portion of which is in the ownership of the Wagon Road Co. If this is done, no doubt time will see the rich sagebrush land irrigated by this company, and whether as beneficial results will follow remains to be seen.
