In the matter of selecting a Newspaper to publish the County Court proceedings for the ensuing year; there being no Newspaper which has filed a list of subscribers, except the Lake County Examiner; It is hereby ordered that the Lake County Examiner, be and it is hereby selected, as the Newspaper to publish the County Court proceedings, as is required by law, for the year ending January 1st 1909.

In the matter of appointing a County Fruit Inspector: It is hereby ordered that Mr. A. M. Smith, of New Pine Creek, Ore, and he is hereby appointed County Fruit Inspector for Lake County, Oregon, as is required and in conformity with law.

Lakeview, Oregon, Jan. 6th 1908. Court convened pursuant to adjournment of Jan. 4th 1908. Same officers present. When the following proceedings were had to wit:

In the matter of the Tax Levy for the year 1908: After a careful examination of the taxable property of Lake County, Oregon, as shown by the Assessment Roll for the year 1907, and of the probable amount of money required to pay the expenses of said County for the ensuing year, and also for the purpose of constructing a Court House for said County, and for such other purposes as are required and in conformity with law:

It is hereby ordered by the County Court of Lake County, Oregon, that a tax levy be and the same is hereby levied upon all the taxable property of said Lake County, Oregon, for the said year of 1908, as follows, to wit:

For County purposes, (Three and three tenths Mills)	.0033
For County School purposes, (Three Mills)	.0030
For the purpose of constructing a Court House building, (Seven Mills)	.0070
For Road purposes (One half Mill)	.0005
Total levy for County, School, Road and Court House purposes	.0138

And that the said rate of Thirteen and Eight Tenths Mills be levied upon each dollar of the taxable property, of Lake County, Oregon, as shown by the Assessment Roll for the year of 1907, and also upon such taxable property as may be assessed by the Sheriff of said County, in conformity with law.

Court adjourned for the term.
